



User Guide for the Electric Bike

RSR Bike — Ride, Sun & Relax

1 TURN ON THE BIKE



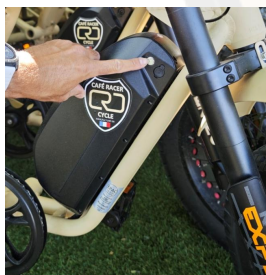
Press the button for **3 seconds**.

2 ENTER THE PASSWORD



Change the number using the **+** and **-** buttons.
Confirm each number with the **red button**.

3 TURN ON THE SECOND BATTERY



The **green** light must be on.
If it is not, press the button.
If the battery has gone into standby mode, turn it off and then back on.

4 FIRST RUN



- Press the trigger to make the bike move forward at 6 km/h.
- Once the bike is in motion, start pedaling.
- Once you have started pedaling, release the trigger.

■ **If you do not release the trigger, you will not exceed 6 km/h.**

Choose the level of electric assistance using the + and – buttons



Mode 1	10 km/h
Mode 2	15 km/h
Mode 3	20 km/h
Mode 4	25 km/h
Mode 5	25 km/h with more torque.

5 THE TURN SIGNALS



Left arrow to activate the left turn signal.
Right arrow to activate the right turn signal.
Press a second time to turn off the turn signal.

6 HORN



Press the microphone to honk the horn.

7 GEAR CHANGE



Rotate the ring to change speed (change the chainring).

7: Small chainring

1: Large chainring

Two adults can ride, but the maximum weight on the bike is 150 kg.

Securing the Bicycle



- Press the locked padlock to arm the alarm.
- Press the open padlock to disarm the alarm.
- Use the key to operate the lock provided with the bike.

There are 2 types of anti-theft devices:



Simple lock, to be attached to the rear wheel by passing through the frame as well.

Next-Generation Anti-Theft Device



1/ Open the lock by unrolling it, starting with the orange link.



2/ Unlock the anti-theft device with the key (if it is not already unlocked).



3/ Pass the lock links through the rear wheel and the frame.



4/ Place the orange link in the slot to lock the padlock and then press the lock.

■ *The bicycle must be secured whenever you stop for several minutes and move away from it.*
